Description of Community Benefit Programs:

Community Health Screenings: This program includes health fairs related to the 2013 and 2016 Community Health Needs Assessments (CHNA) and Implementation strategies. The most recent 2016 CHNA identified the priority health needs to include Diabetes management, Obesity, and overall greater access to healthcare. To meet that need, 2016-2019 health fairs include the testing of A1C, Blood Pressure, Glucose, Cholesterol, & Body Mass Index (BMI) testing with the facilitation of one or more Registered Nurses at each event.

Community Education: In relation to the most recent 2016 CHNA and Implementation Strategy, community education includes Monthly Diabetic Support Groups and seminars focusing on Diabetes prevention and Education with the facilitation of a Diabetic Nurse Educator. Other monthly community education programs/seminars include Obesity Prevention, Nutritional Services, Community CPR Trainings, and Community Flu Shot clinics and other population health initiatives.
