Notice to Attorney General Pursuant to CA Corp. Code Section 5920

A description of each measure proposed by the applicant to mitigate or eliminate any potential adverse effect on the availability or accessibility of health care services to the affected community that may result from the agreement of transaction.

The Applicant has required Adventist Health to agree in the Affiliation Agreement (Tab (1)(B) – 1) to a variety of measures in the Affiliation Agreement to maintain and enhance the delivery of health care at the Hospital, including:

- Operating the Hospital as a general acute care hospital with not less than the existing licensed bed count, by category;
- Develop a new obstetrics unit with not less than 12 separate, individual rooms;
- Continued participation in the Medicare, Medi-Cal and TRICARE programs;
- Adoption of the Adventist Health charity care policy at the Hospital;
- Implementation of various Adventist Health physician recruitment and maintenance programs;
- Implementation of various cost-savings measures, including the Adventist Health EMR solution, access to Adventist Health credit support to reduce borrowing costs, and participation in the Adventist Health corporate services programs; and
- To assure observance of these agreements throughout the ten-year term of the Affiliation Agreement, a prohibition against any transaction that would result in a change of control of the Hospital.
